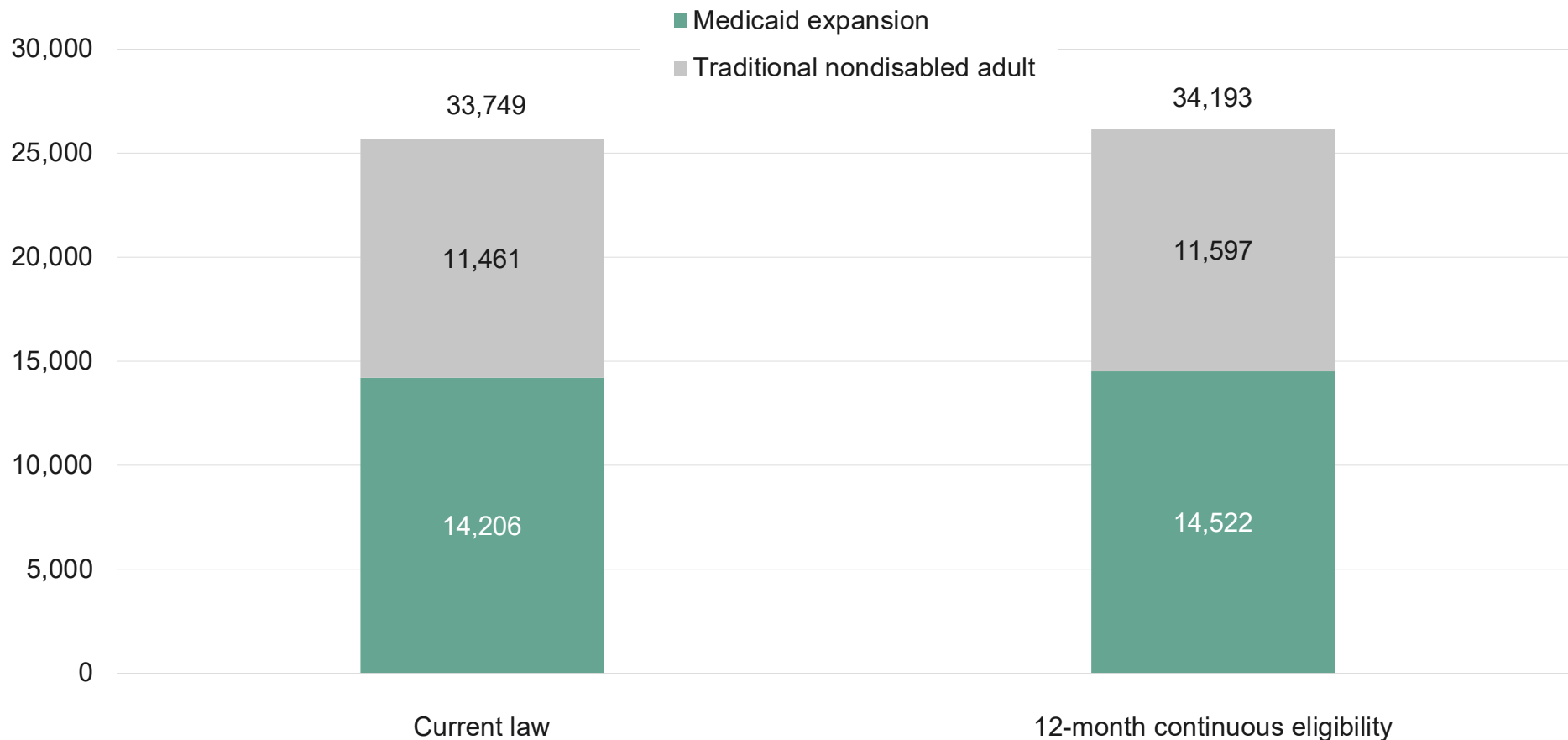
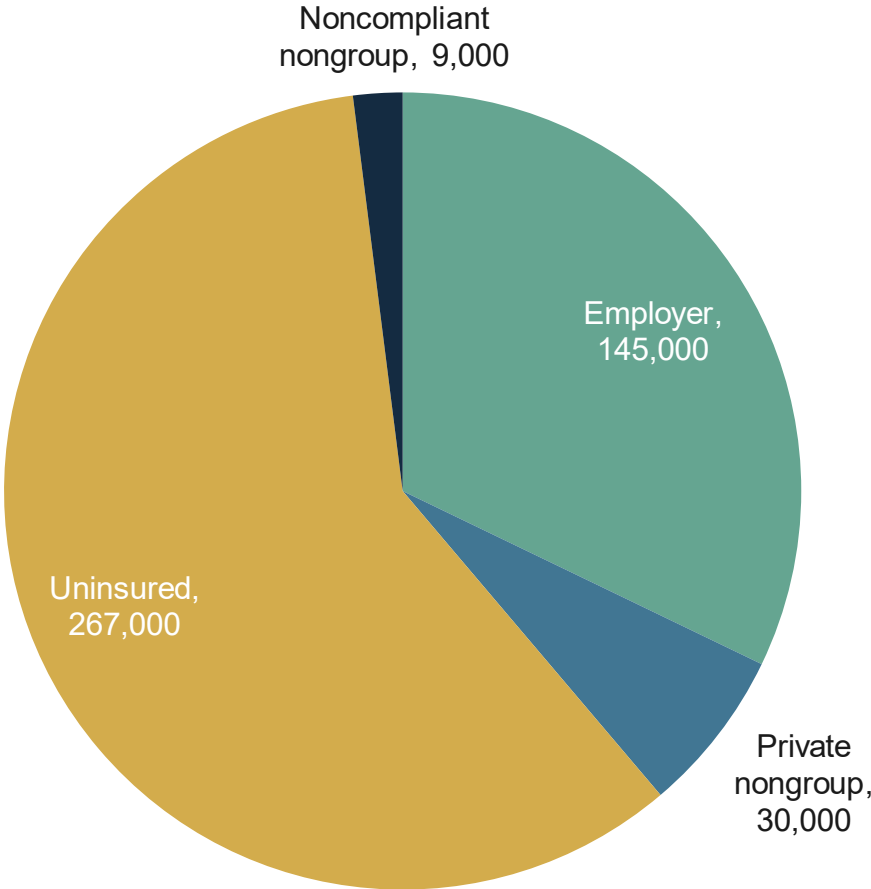


Changes in Adult Medicaid Enrollment of Nonelderly Adults if All States Extended 12-Month Continuous Eligibility in 2024



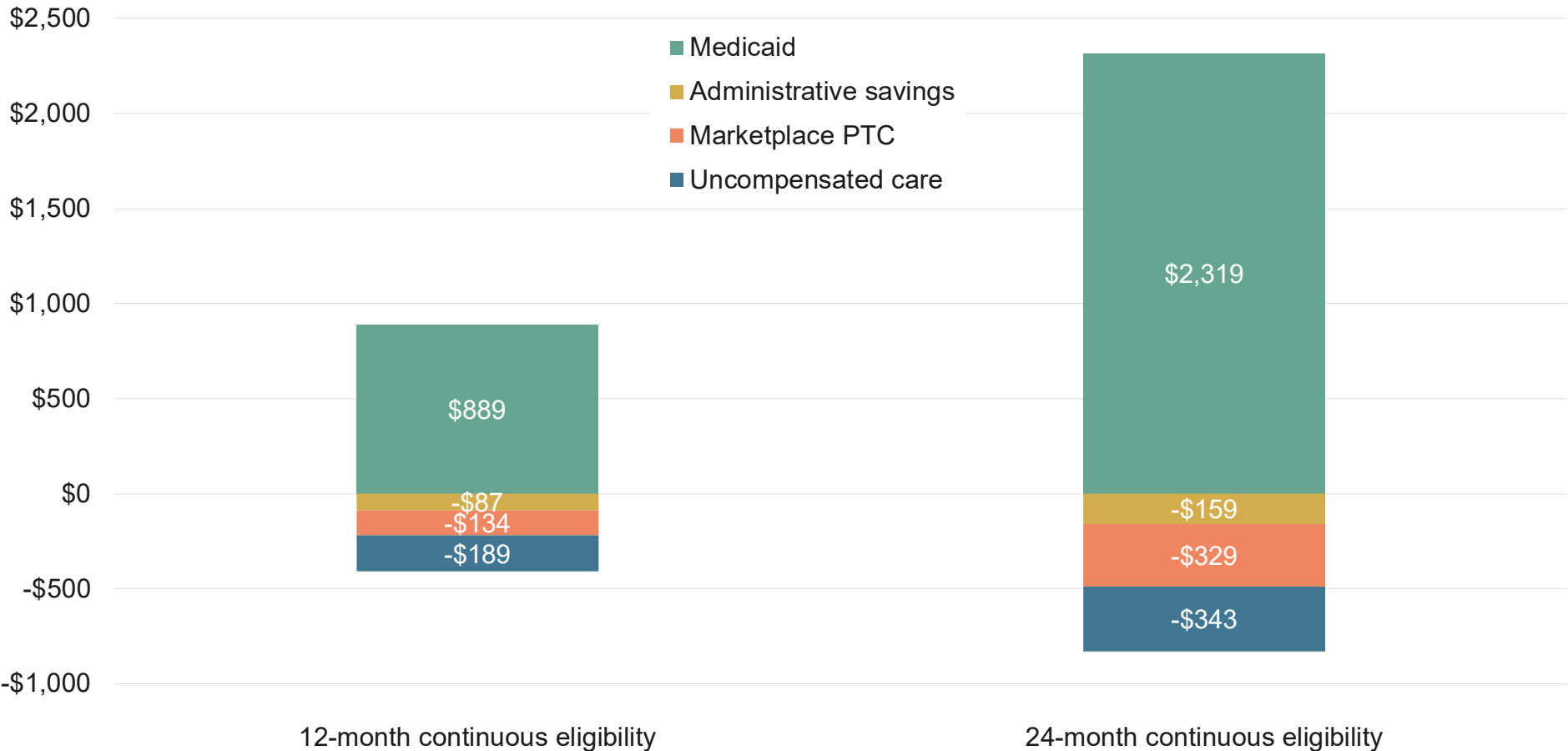

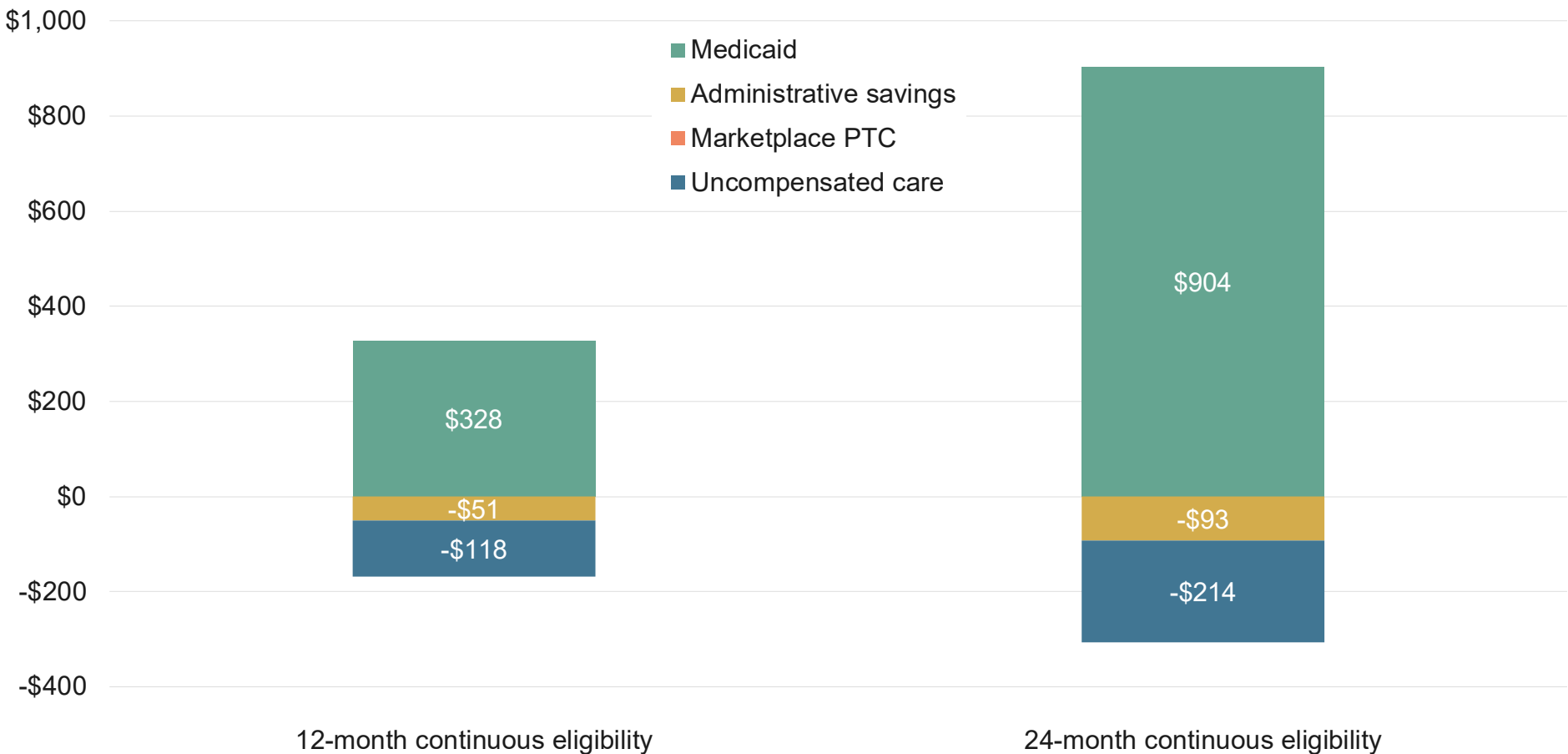
Changes in Federal Spending if States Extend 12-Month Adult Continuous Eligibility in 2024 (\$ millions)

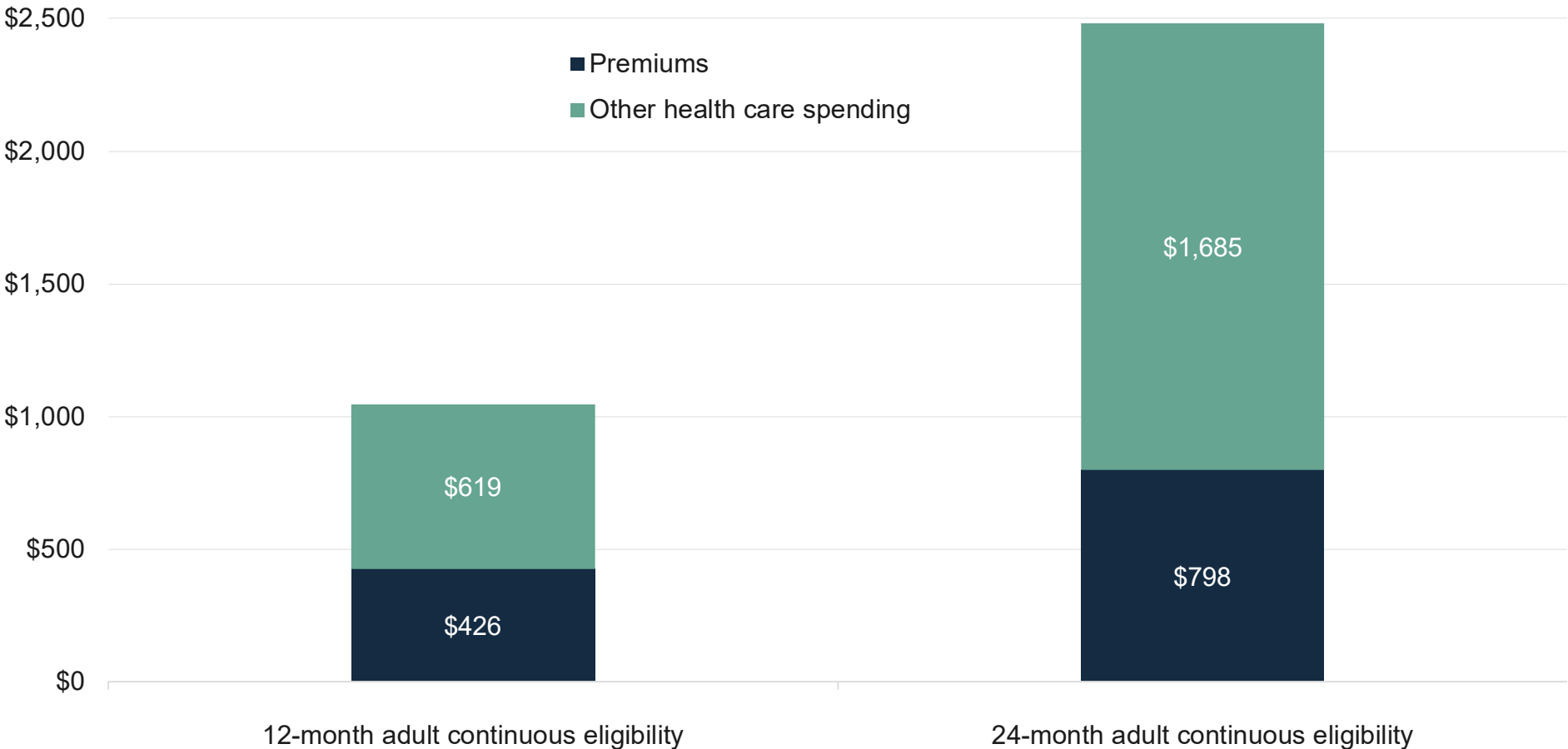
Changes in State Spending if States Extend 12-Month Adult Continuous Eligibility in 2024 (\$ millions)
